

The Insurance bet wins if a player's hand is an ace-high or less. Players will receive their seven cards and arrange them into a four-card "high" hand, a two-card "mid" hand, and a one-card "low" hand. After setting their hands, they place them in the marked areas. The Dealer then reveals their cards and sets their hand. If a Player needs assistance setting their hand, the Dealer will set the hand per the House Way (the way the Dealer is required to set their hand).

# FORTUNE ASIA POKER

Asia Poker is based on the ancient Asian game called "13" and combines poker with pai gow poker. The game is played with a traditional deck of 52 cards plus one Joker, which can be used as an Ace or as any card to complete a Straight, Flush, Straight Flush or Royal Flush. Seven cards are dealt to each Player and the Dealer, who arrange the cards into three hands- one card, two cards and four cards. If the Player has two of their three hands higher in rank than the Dealer, the Player wins.

## HAND RANKINGS

**4 Aces** A hand consisting of four Aces

**Royal Flush** A hand consisting of an Ace, King, Queen, Jack of the same suit

**Straight Flush** A hand consisting of four of the same suit in consecutive ranking. Ace, 2,3,4 is the highest straight flush and King, Queen, Jack, 10 is the second highest straight flush

**Four-of-a-Kind** A hand consisting of four cards of the same rank regardless of suit. Four Aces is the highest ranking hand and four 2's is the lowest ranking hand

**Flush** A hand consisting of four cards of the same suit, regardless of rank

**Straight** A hand consisting of four cards of consecutive rank, regardless of suit. An Ace, King, Queen, Jack is the highest ranking hand, an Ace, 2,3,4 is the second highest ranking hand and 5,4,3,2 is the lowest ranking hand

**Three-of-a-Kind** A hand consisting of three cards of the same rank regardless of the suit. Three Aces is the highest ranking hand and three 2's is the lowest ranking hand

**Two Pair** A hand consisting of two pairs of the same ranking, regardless of suit. Two Aces and two Kings is the highest ranking hand and two 3's and two 2's is the lowest ranking hand

**Pair** Either hand consisting of two cards of the same ranking, regardless of suit. Two Aces is the highest ranking hand and two 2's is the lowest ranking hand.

## HOW TO PLAY

To begin, Players must make the basic bet against the Dealer and can also make the two optional bets - Fortune Bonus and Insurance. After Players make their bets, they will get seven cards to make three poker hands: a four-card hand, a two-card hand, and a one-card hand. The only rule for setting their hands is that their four-card hand must be higher than their two-card hand, and their two-card hand must be higher than their one-card hand. The Dealer must set his or her hand per the specified house way. Each of the Players' three hands will matchup against the Dealer's corresponding hand. Player must win 2 or more hands to win, or lose 2 or more hands to lose. The house wins ties (copy hands). The Fortune Bonus bet wins if a Player's hand contains a straight or better.
