

RIVERS SPORTSBOOK

DISCLAIMER: This is a Summary of the Complete House Rules for the benefit of Rivers Casino & Resort patrons. The Complete House Rules are available upon request at the Rivers Sportsbook and are posted on the Rivers Casino & Resort website.

SUMMARY OF WAGERING RULES

1. INTRODUCTION

1. The Complete House Rules govern the use of the Rivers Sportsbook. When placing a wager with Rivers Casino & Resort, the patron is therefore agreeing that the patron has read, understood and will adhere to the Complete House Rules.
2. The operation of this Sportsbook is subject to the regulations promulgated by the New York State Gaming Commission.
3. Any dispute relating in any way to the use of the Sportsbook should be submitted by contacting a Sportsbook Supervisor or Manager during normal hours of operation.
4. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to make changes to the wagering limits, pay-out limits and offerings at any time.
5. Rivers Casino & Resort may update, amend, edit or supplement the Complete House Rules at any time.
6. Any reference in the Complete House Rules or the Summary to words/objects that appear singularly also applies to plural. References to gender are non-binding and to be treated for information purposes only.
7. Rivers Casino & Resort will not accept any wager from persons under the age of twenty-one (21) or persons prohibited from engaging in sports wagering or gaming activities per §5329.19 and §5326 of the New York State Regulations. Some examples are: No collegiate or professional athlete, referee, official, coach, manager, handler or athletic trainer or employee or contractor of a team or athletic organization can wager on events that they are directly or indirectly involved in.

2. DEFINITIONS

1. "Error" is a mistake, misprint, misinterpretation, mishearing, misreading, mistranslation, spelling mistakes, technical hazard, registration error, transaction errors, manifest errors, force majeure and/or similar. Examples of errors include, but are not limited to:
 - Wagers accepted during technical problems that would otherwise not have been accepted;
 - Wagers placed on events/offers that have already been decided;
 - Wagers on markets containing incorrect participants;
 - Wagers placed at odds that are materially different from those available in the general market at the time the wager was placed;
 - Wagers offered at odds which reflect an incorrect score situation; or else,
 - Odds being clearly incorrect given the chance of the event occurring at the time the wager was placed.
2. "Influence Wagering" is an act, prohibited by Rivers Casino & Resort, where a patron, or parties acting in association with a patron, can influence the outcome of a match or an event—directly or indirectly.
3. "Syndicate Wagering" is an act, prohibited by Rivers Casino & Resort, where patrons act together to place a series of wagers on the same event or competition. Where there is evidence of patrons acting together in this manner, Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to make the relevant wagers void and/or withhold payment of returns pending the outcome of subsequent investigations.

3. WAGER ACCEPTANCE

1. A wager is not valid until it is confirmed and the ticket has been printed. In cases of uncertainty about the validity of a bet, patrons should contact Sportsbook Management.
2. Once accepted, a wager will remain valid and cannot be withdrawn. It is the responsibility of the patron to ensure the details of the wagers placed are correct. Rivers Casino & Resort will under no circumstance accept any responsibility for mistakes (perceived and actual), derived from either Errors as listed in the Complete Wagering Rules, or any other reason, such as but not limited to, incorrect listing of the odds/wagering objects.
3. Should a dispute arise from any transaction, the transaction server database will be the ultimate authority in resolving such matters.
4. Rivers Casino & Resort will only accept cash and sports wagering vouchers for sports wagers.

4. TICKETS

1. Please check your ticket for accuracy, as all tickets are final after leaving the wagering counter. Once a wager is final, tickets will not be altered or voided except at the discretion of Sportsbook Management.
2. No winning wager will be paid without the customer copy of the wagering ticket.
3. Management is not responsible for lost, stolen, altered or unreadable tickets.
4. Winning tickets expire after one (1) year from the date of the event.
5. Mail-in instructions for winning tickets are printed on the ticket. Mail tickets or vouchers to: Rivers Casino & Resort ATTN: Cage Director 1 Rush Street Schenectady, NY 12305.

5. WAGERING AND PAY-OUT LIMITATIONS

1. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to limit the net pay-out on any wager or combination of wagers by a single patron prior to the placement of wagers. This limit may be determined on the specific sport, league and type of wager offer.
2. All wager selections are subject to pre-imposed limits set solely at Rivers Casino & Resort's discretion. Should this limit be reached, a patron has the right to ask to exceed the limit by making a request via Rivers Casino & Resort's management. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to accept (fully or partially) or reject the said request without any prior notice nor further explanation.
3. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to withhold payment and/or to declare wagers void on an event (or series of events), if there is sufficient evidence that any of the following has occurred:
 - The integrity of the event has been called into question;
 - The price(s) or pool has been manipulated;
 - Game-fixing has taken place, or the game is under investigation of such.
4. All odds offered are subject to variation. Such fluctuation is determined solely at Rivers Casino & Resort's discretion. Wagers are accepted only at the odds available in the wagering platform at the time the wager was accepted by Rivers Casino & Resort. Odd changes are reflected in real time on electronic signage, automated ticket machines and the Sportsbook Writer over the counter wagering terminals.
5. When settling wagers, all pay-out calculations will be based on the decimal equivalent of the American odds displayed/chosen at time of wager placement. For example, American odds +100 = 2.00 decimal equivalency. A winning \$5.00 wager at +100 odds would pay \$10.00—\$5.00 winnings + \$5.00 initial stake.

6. CANCELLATION (VOIDING) OF WAGERS

1. A wager can be declared void, and will be refunded to the patron in that event.
2. A parlay wager shall remain valid, even in the event a game which is part of the parlay wager is declared void.
3. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to declare a wager void, in full or in part, if any of the following circumstances have occurred:
 - Wagers have been offered, placed and/or accepted due to an Error;
 - Wagers placed while the platform was encountering technical problems, that would otherwise not have been accepted;
 - Influence Wagering;
 - Syndicate Wagering;
 - A result has been affected by criminal actions—directly or indirectly;
 - A public announcement has occurred in relation to the wager which significantly alters the odds.
4. A parlay wager shall never include two (2) or more offers where the outcomes may be related. Although Rivers Casino & Resort takes all necessary steps to prevent such possibilities, in the event that this would happen, Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to void all parts of the parlay wager which include the correlated outcomes.
5. Wagers can be voided regardless of whether or not the event has been settled.
6. All wagers placed (and/or accepted) in the following circumstances will be declared void:

Pre-game Wagering

- Wagers placed after the event has started;
- Wagers placed after a related event was underway and where conditions could have been altered in a direct and indisputable way. For example, late season contests where preceding games/events and the action taking place within them may determine the game strategy and likely outcome of later contests.

In-game Wagering

- Wagers placed at an incorrect price due to delayed or failed "Live" coverage;
- Wagers placed on offers after the offers have occurred, or after an event which could normally be deemed as leading to the outcome has happened or is happening;
- Wagers placed on odds which represent a different score than the actual.

7. DISCLAIMER AND PRIORITY

1. Any complaints/disagreements toward settlement of any wager offer, must be brought to Rivers Casino & Resort's attention within fourteen (14) days of the initial settlement in order to fully investigate.
2. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to suspend the status of any affected wagers until the completion of an investigation.
3. These rules are applicable to all transactions with Rivers Sportsbook, and may be supplemented with other rules. In the event of ambiguity, priority should be considered in the following order:
 - Rules and conditions published in conjunction with an offer and/or campaign; and
 - If the published rules and conditions are inconclusive, reference will be made to the Complete Wagering Rules, unless Specific Sports Wagering Rules declare otherwise.

GENERAL WAGERING RULES

1. COMMON TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. "In-game wagering" is where it is possible to wager during an ongoing game or event.
2. The "Cash Out" function allows a patron the possibility of redeeming a bet, which status has not been settled yet, at its current value. It is available on selected events both in pre-game and in-game, as well as on both singles and parlays. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to determine when and on which games/events to offer the "Cash Out" function.
3. The lock time shown on tickets, kiosks and digital signage is for informational purposes only. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to suspend, fully or partially, the wagering activity.
4. The stated lock time for pre-game wagers will coincide with the start of each offered event/market. No pre-game wagers will be accepted on an event after the official start of an event.
5. The lock time for in-game wagering will vary based on the start, progression and/or completion of the specified action within live competition. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to determine when and on which games/events to offer in-game wagering.

2. WAGER TYPES

1. Moneyline (to win) is a wager on the outcome of a game or event, i.e. who will win.
2. Spread wagering ("Point spread" in Football and Basketball, "Run Line" in Baseball, "Puck Line" in Hockey or "Handicap") is a wager on whether the chosen outcome will be victorious once the listed spread/line is added/subtracted to the game/period/total score. In those circumstances where the result after the adjustment of the spread/line is exactly equal to the wagering line, then all wagers on this offer will be declared a push and wagers will be refunded.
3. "Over/Under" (Totals) is a wager on the amount of a predefined occurrence (e.g. points, runs, goals). Should the total amount of the listed occurrence be exactly equal to the wagering line, then all wagers on this offer will be declared a push and wagers will be refunded.
4. Futures ("Outright" or "Place") wagering is where it is possible to choose from a list of alternatives and wager on the eventuality that a participant/team wins or places within a specified position in the classification of the listed event/competition.
5. Three (3)-way Moneyline is where it is possible to wager on three (3) outcomes of a game or event. The options are: Home team to win, Tie or Away team to win.

3. PARLAY/SYSTEM WAGERS/ROUND ROBINS

1. With pre-game wagering, it is possible to combine up to twelve (12) different games/outcomes on a single wagering ticket. Patrons can choose their own single bet or place parlays containing between two (2) and twelve (12) different legs (individual games/outcomes). Combining different parlays on a single wagering ticket is sometimes called Round Robin wagering.
2. With in-game wagering, it is possible to combine up to twelve (12) different offers on a single wagering ticket as a parlay bet. All selected games/offers in a parlay must be included on the wagering ticket and no other parlay option (Example: singles, doubles, etc.) which exclude one (1) or more games/offers are available, i.e. Round Robins are not available for in-game betting parlays.
3. Rivers Casino & Resort reserves the right to limit the amount of combinations due to what is known as outcome dependency.

4. RESULT SETTLEMENT

1. Settlement of wagers will not include and is not limited to any changes deriving from and/or attributable to: disqualifications, penalizations, protests, sub judice results and/or successive changes to the official result after the event has been completed and the result has been announced, even preliminarily.
2. Occurrences which have not been sanctioned and/or acknowledged by the game/match/event officials (e.g. disallowed touchdowns) will not be taken into account toward the settlement of the bet.
3. All wager offers related to games/matches/events which do not take place or are awarded a result through a forfeit/"walk-over" decision will be declared void and wagers will be refunded.
4. Settlement of wager offers, such as, but not limited to, stolen bases, sacks, shots, shots on target, ball possession, assists, rebounds, etc. will be based according to the definition with which the official governing body issues said statistics.
5. When placing Futures ("Outright" or "Place") wagers, no wagers will be refunded based on either a participant not participating or having withdrawn from an event (both prior and during), unless otherwise stated.
6. In a "Head-to-Head" between two (2) or three (3) participants, for wagers to be considered valid, all listed participants must start the particular round/event which the wager refers.

SPECIFIC SPORTS WAGERING RULES

ALL CONDITIONS STATED IN THIS SECTION HAVE PRIORITY TO ANY OTHER RULE OR CONDITION.

1. FOOTBALL

1. Unless otherwise stated, all wagers on Football are determined based on the result after the game is over, including overtime.
2. All offers will be declared void unless fifty-five (55) minutes of play have been completed, except for those where the outcome of which have been decided prior to the abandonment and could not possibly be changed regardless of future events.
3. "Head-to-Head" and "Over/Under" wagers involving one or more players' performance in the game/league are considered valid, provided that all listed players participate in the game/league at some stage for wagers to stand.

2. BASEBALL

1. Unless otherwise stated, wagers on Baseball are determined based on the result after any eventual extra innings, regardless of the amount of innings played.
2. A wager is declared void on a cancelled or postponed game which has not started, or in the case of a result not having been issued within twelve (12) hours of the scheduled start time.
3. Moneyline ("Match") wagers will be declared a push in the case of a tie after the eventual extra innings. All other offers which could reasonably be settled (e.g. "Totals", Run Line) will be settled according to the result after the extra innings.
4. Run Line ("Spread" or "Handicap"), "Totals" and "Odd/Even" wagers require all scheduled innings to be completed, or at least eight and a half (8.5) innings are completed, if the home team is in advantage, for wagers to stand.
5. Moneyline ("Match") wagers require a minimum of five (5) full innings to be played or at least four and a half (4.5) innings in case the team batting second is leading at that particular point.

3. BASKETBALL

1. A wager on Basketball is determined based on the result after the game is over, including overtime, unless otherwise stated.

4. ICE HOCKEY

1. Settlement of player related wagers in a specific game will be based on the result after the end of the 3rd period (Regular Time), unless otherwise stated.
2. For the purpose of settlement, "Over/Under" wagers referring to Total Goals Scored in the game, including any eventual goals scored in Overtime and Penalty Shoot-outs, will be settled by counting only one (1) goal for the winning team, regardless of how goals are scored by either team during the Overtime/Penalty Shoot-out.
3. Unless specifically stated or implied within the offer, all wagers on Ice Hockey are determined based on the result at the end of Regular Time (i.e. end of 3rd Period).

5. SOCCER

1. Regular time for soccer is ninety (90) minutes including any added/injury time.
2. Three (3)-way Moneyline wagers include the option of a tie. The three (3) options are: Home team to win, Tie or Away team to win.

6. GOLF

1. All wagers will be deemed as valid if the tournament, or the relative round to which the wager refers, is played within the same year, irrespective of any time delays, unless other arrangements have been agreed.
2. All wagers referring to tournament performance (Winner, Place, etc.) will be deemed valid if thirty-six (36) holes have been completed by the eligible players and an official result has been declared by the governing body.
3. Wagers on players who start the tournament but withdraw voluntarily or are disqualified will be settled as losing wagers, unless the result of the offer which the wager refers to is already determined.

7. BOXING/MMA

1. All offers will be settled according to the official result of the relevant governing body immediately as declared by the ring announcer at the end of the fight.
2. For settlement purposes, in case the match is interrupted for any reason in between rounds, e.g. retirement before the start of a round, disqualification, failure to answer the bell, the match will be deemed to have finished at the end of the previous round.
3. Offers on matches declared "No Contest" or "Technical draw" will be settled as void, except for those offers where the outcome has been decided prior to the decision and could not possibly be changed regardless of future events, which will be settled according to the decided outcome.
